

# Dos Rios Light Rail Station Project

The new Dos Rios Station will be located on the Blue Line, on North 12th Street between Richards Boulevard and Sunbeam Avenue in Sacramento.

## RIDER IMPACT

Light rail service will not be impacted until summer 2025.

## **COMMUNITY IMPACT**

Road closures will be in place for two years starting in November 2024 on Ahern Street and Sproule Ave. Local property owners will continue to have access.

#### **CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE**

## November 18, 2024:

Ahern Ave and Sproule Ave will be closed (pending City approval). Only local property owners will have access during the two-year closure.

## Late 2024 - Early 2025:

Retaining wall construction at Loaves and Fishes parking lot.

## July 2025:

First weekend light rail service disruption for new outbound track work.

## October 2025:

Second and third weekend service disruptions to finalize outbound track work.

## April 2026:

Fourth weekend service disruption to switch to the new inbound track.


## September 2026:

Station construction is expected to be completed.

Please note that this schedule may shift due to weather or other factors.

## PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Dos Rios Station is part of a larger community development initiative, which includes affordable housing, supported by a \$23 million Transformative Climate Communities (TCC) Grant from the California Strategic Growth Council. This project aims to bring environmental, health, and economic benefits to Sacramento's underserved communities.
