KEY IMPROVEMENTS

Project Overview

Construction is underway on the Watt/I-80 Transit Center Improvement Project. This initiative aims to create a safer, more accessible environment at one of the region's largest transit hubs.

New Bus/Pedestrian Plaza

I-80 On-Ramp Improvements

**Upgrades to Transit Center
Beneath Watt Avenue**

These enhancements are designed to attract more riders, accommodate additional bus service from regional operators, and significantly improve overall safety.

Impact on Riders and Drivers



Temporary Modifications: Expect changes in bus service and potential delays for drivers due to lane closures.



Advance Notice: SacRT will notify riders of any service changes or access restrictions in advance.



Anticipated Construction Schedule

July 15 - Mid-August 2024

Bus lane modifications at the light rail station (no rider impact).

Late July - October 2024

Watt Avenue median replacement (lane closures on Watt Avenue).

August - September 2024

Further bus lane modifications at the light rail station (temporary bus stop relocations).

September 2024 - February 2025

West side Watt Ave construction, bus plaza (upper deck) and stairs.

December 2024 - March 2025

South on-ramp construction (lane and ramp closures expected).

February - September 2025

Continued west side Watt Ave construction, bus plaza, and stairs.

March - May 2025

North on-ramp construction (lane and ramp closures expected).

September - November 2025

Final Watt Avenue and on-ramp construction (lane and ramp closures expected).

Project Completion

The Watt/I-80 Transit Center Improvement Project is expected to be completed in early 2026.
